
Wanderers: A Post-Apocalyptic Epic by Chuck Wendig



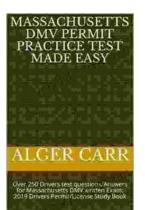

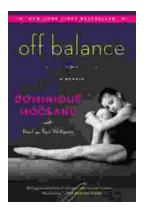
